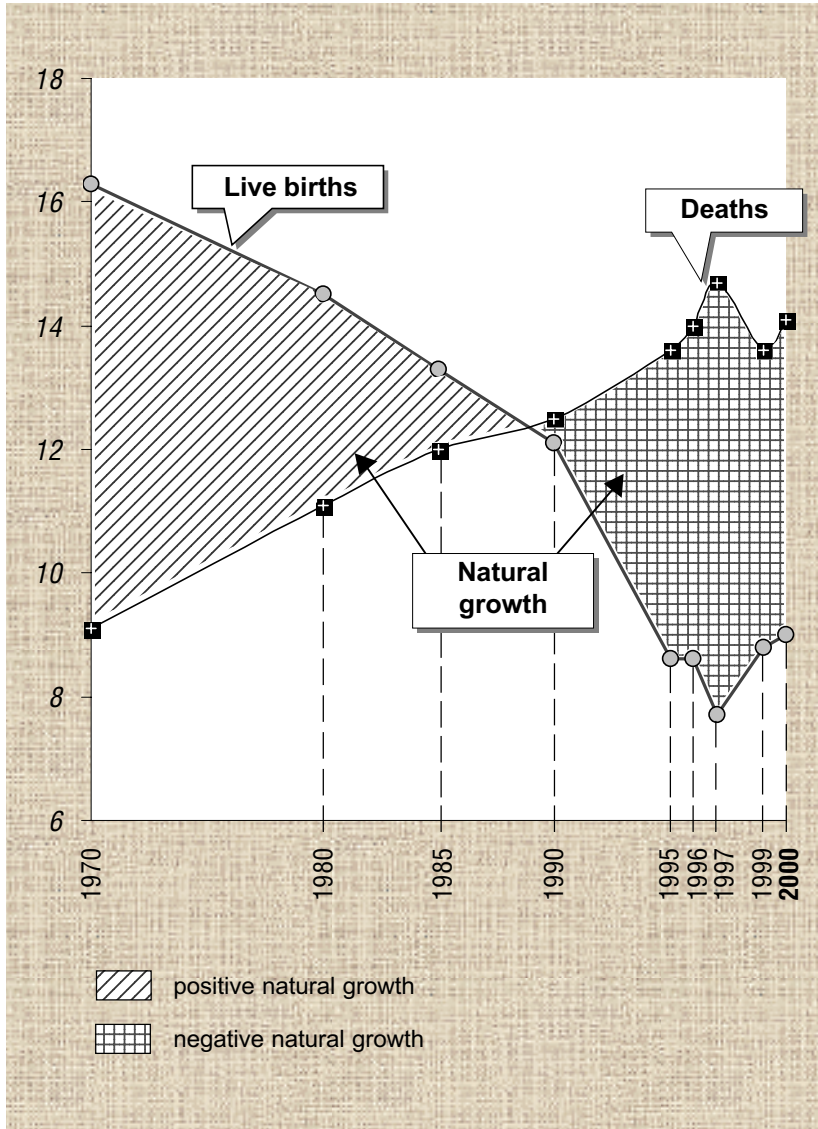

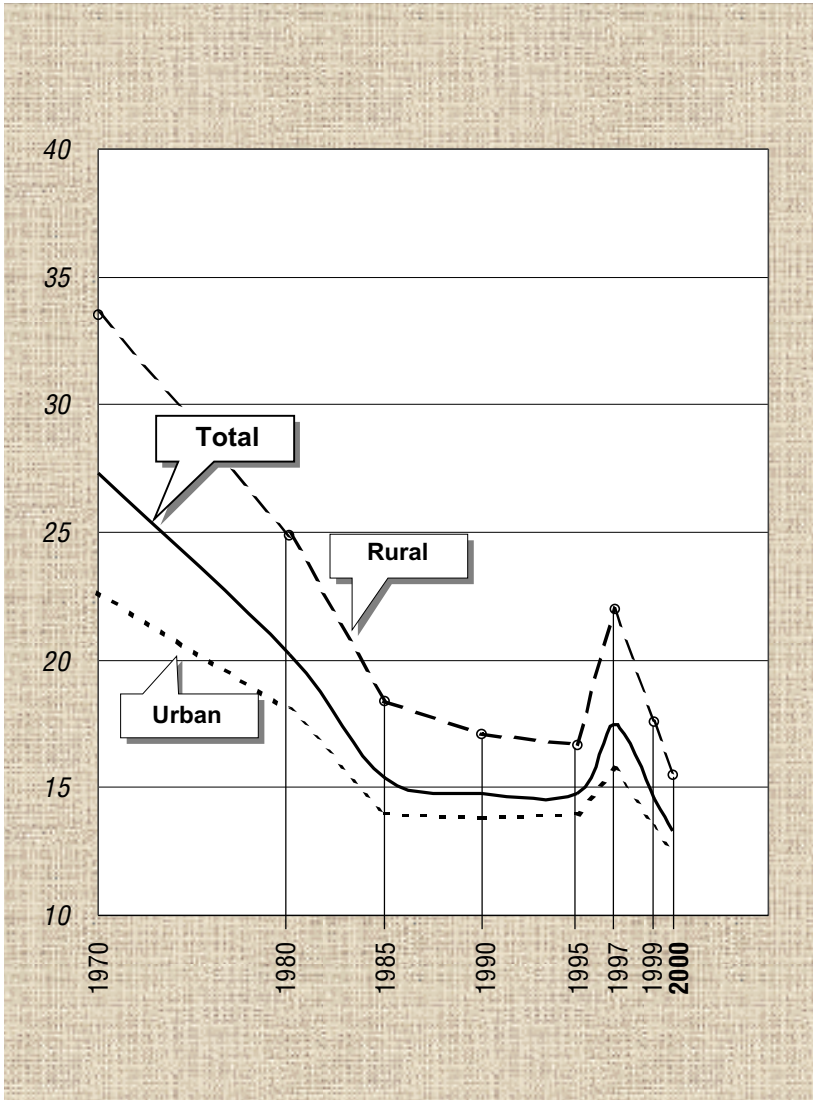

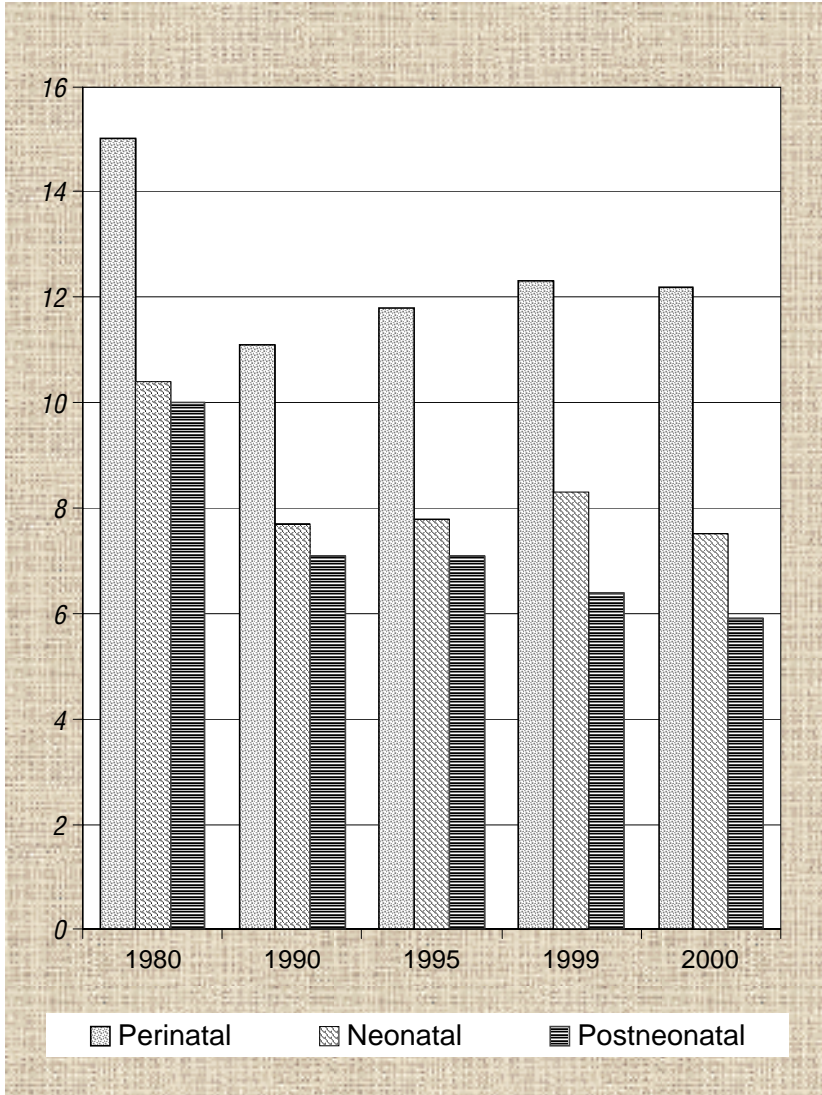
Infant Mortality

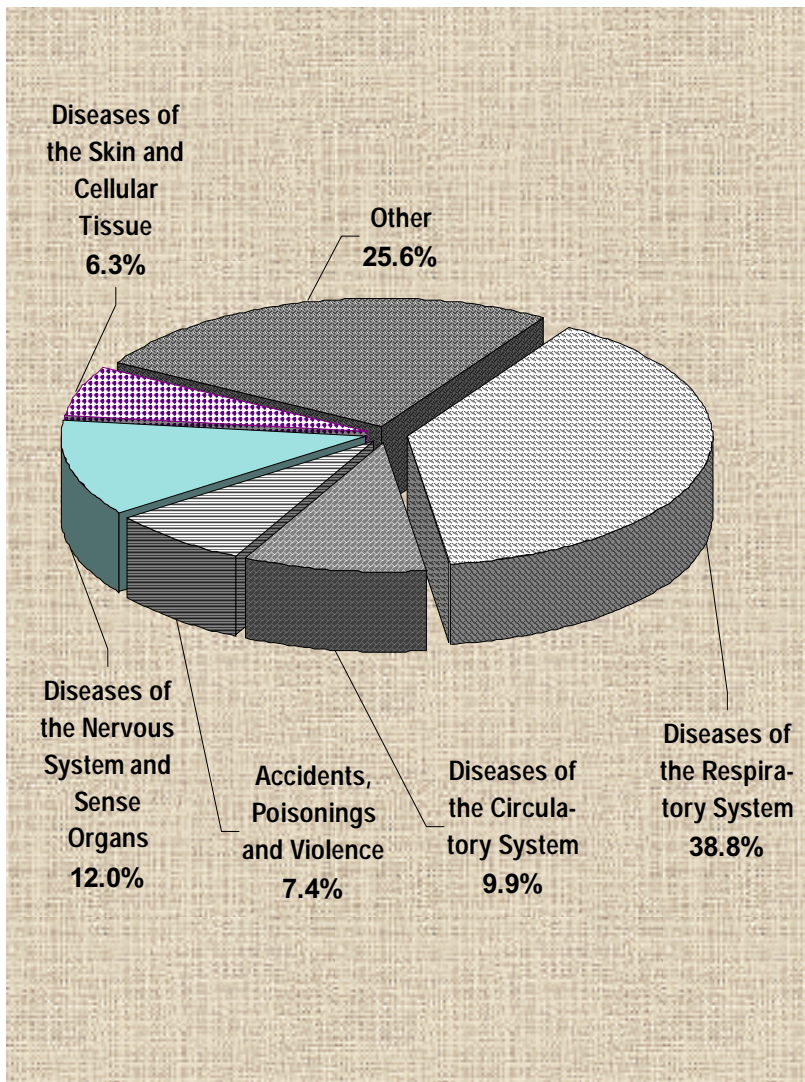

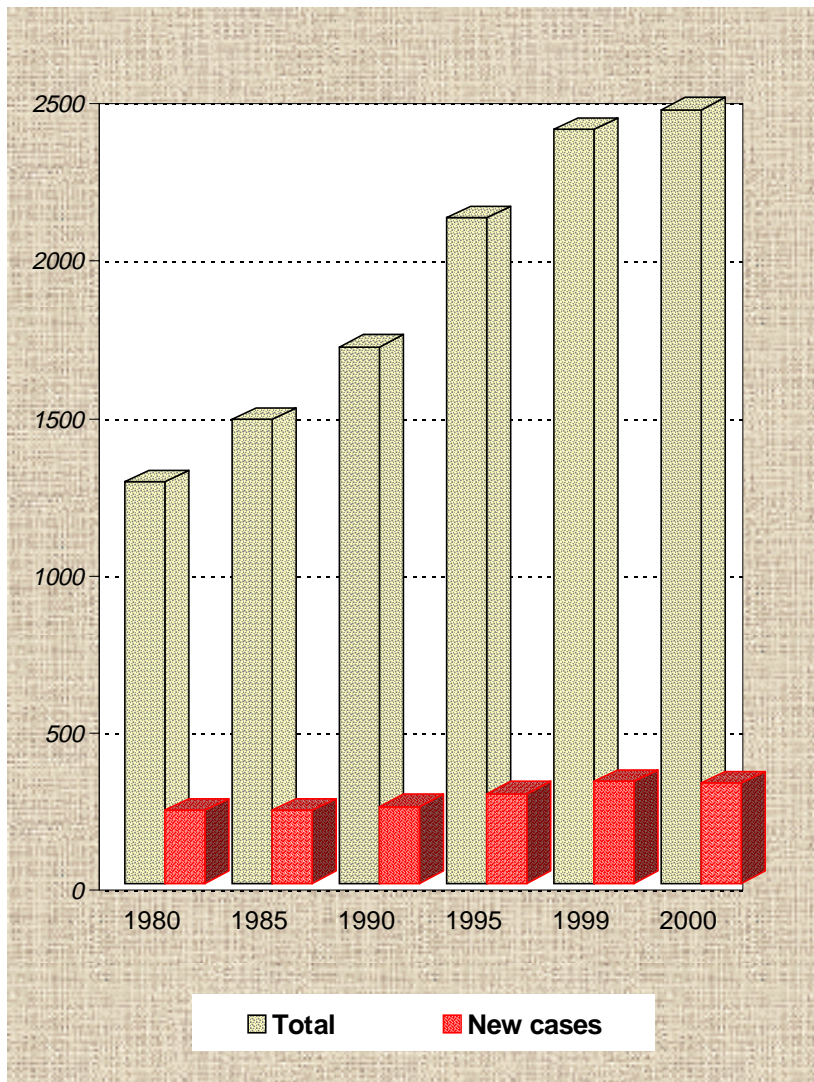

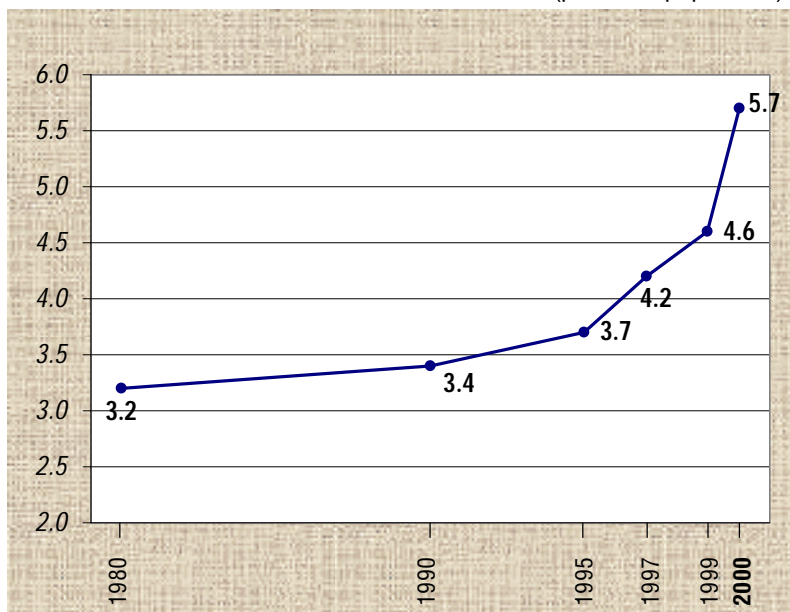

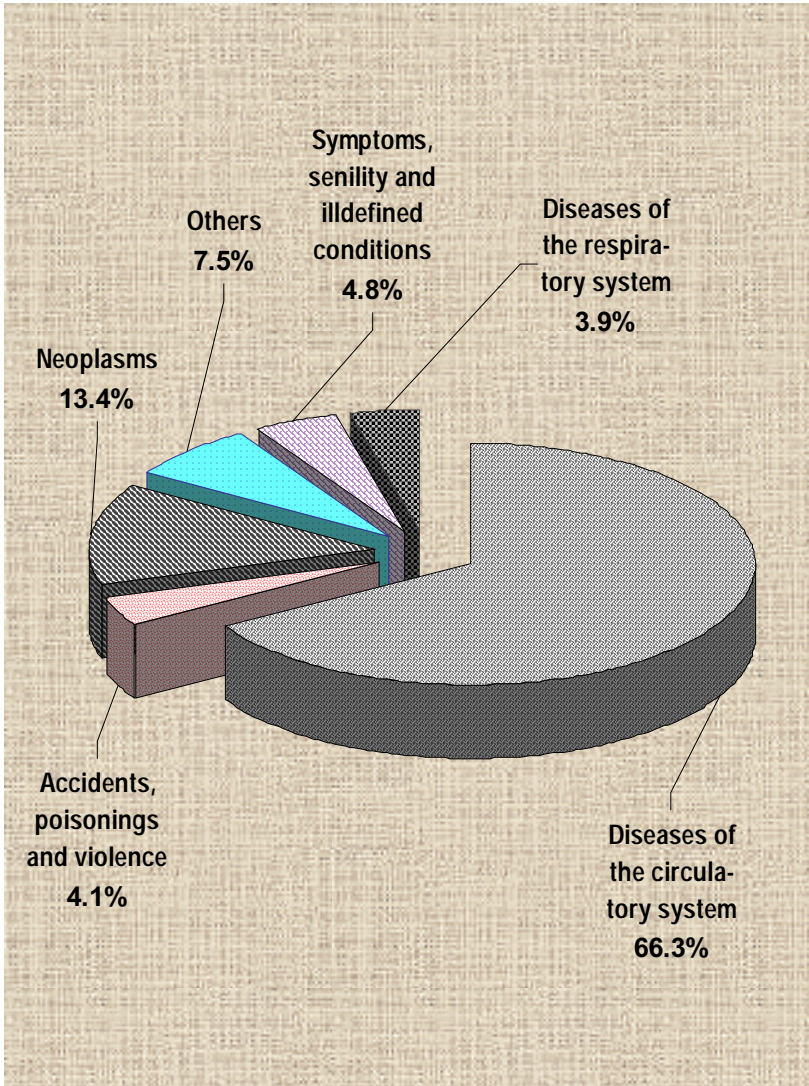

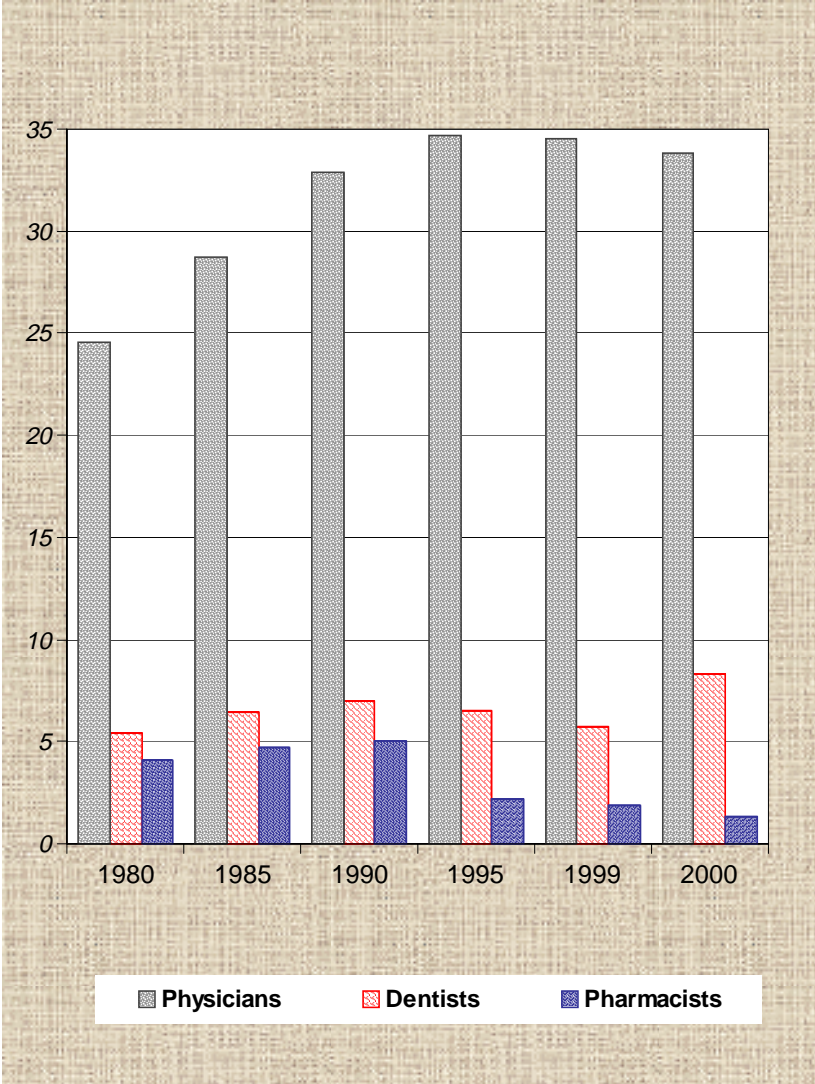
